KEYNOTE SPEAKER



DARREN LACROIX, CSP, AS, WCPS KEYNOTE SPEAKER

He felt invisible in high school. He failed as a business owner.

He worked in a cubicle for over a decade.

Today he's a world champion speaker. What made the difference for him can make the difference for you.

A Real-Life Underdog Story Filled with Humor and Hope

After a failed business in 1992, Darren LaCroix took the stage in a Boston comedy club and bombed miserably. It was horrible. The headliner that night told him to "keep his day job." Friends told him that his dream of making people laugh for a living was crazy and stupid. He didn't listen.

He may have been born without a funny bone in his body, but Darren possessed the desire to learn and the willingness to fail. These were the essentials for achieving his dream. This self-proclaimed student of comedy is living proof that anything can be learned.

Less than nine years later, in 2001, Darren LaCroix outspoke 25,000 contestants from 14 countries to become the World Champion of Public Speaking. He did it with a very funny speech. Some said it was one of the best speeches in the history of the contest.

Since that victory, Darren travels the world demystifying the process of creating a powerful presentation. His story has inspired audiences in 45 International cities including faraway places like Australia, Singapore, Saudi Arabia, China, Oman, Malaysia, and Taiwan with his inspirational journey from Chump to Champ. He is passionate about showing people that if you are a sponge and have the right mentors, anything is possible.

Darren is currently the only speaker in the world who is a CSP (Certified Speaking Professional), an AS (Accredited Speaker), and a World Champion of Public Speaking. Darren always stresses, "Don't go for the designations to get letters after your name; do it for the professional you will become in the process."

He is the co-host of Unforgettable Presentations podcast and also the coauthor for two books, Laugh & Get Rich and the Speaker's Edge. Through his live workshops and online programs, Darren works with presenters eager to learn what it takes to connect deeply with their audiences. As the founder of StageTimeUniversity.com he shows presenters how to be unforgettable.

MARILU HENNER

Communication & Leadership Award Honoree

PRESENTED AT HALL OF FAME

With the energy of a teenager, the wisdom of a sage, and the memory of a superhero, Marilu Henner has done it all. Along with starring in sixty-eight films, seven Broadway shows, and two hit classic sitcoms, *Taxi* and *Evening Shade*, this five-time Golden Globe Nominee is the *New York Times* Best Selling author of ten books on health, parenting, memory, and lifestyle improvement. Her books *Total Health Makeover*, *The 30-Day Total Health Makeover*, *I Refuse to Raise a Brat*, *Healthy Life Kitchen*, *Healthy Kids*, *Healthy Holidays*, *Wear Your Life Well*, *By All Means Keep On Moving*, *Total Memory Makeover*, and *Changing Normal: How I Helped My Husband Beat Cancer* have changed the lives of millions in her quest to make the world a healthier place.

Marilu has hosted and executive produced a nationally syndicated radio show, *The Marilu Henner Show*, as well as two talk shows (*Marilu* and *Shape Up Your Life*) and has guest-starred on every major talk show, earning her the title "Talk Show Guest of the Year" several years in a row.

Marilu was honored with the Voice of Compassion Award at the Physicians' Committee for Responsible Medicine 25th Anniversary Gala. In 2016, she competed on the 23rd season of *Dancing with the Stars* on ABC making it to the semi-finals.

One of only twelve people documented with Highly Superior Autobiographical Memory (HSAM), Marilu was the subject of a three-part special on *60 Minutes* and on *60 Minutes Australia*, as well as news programs and newspaper articles around the globe.

Marilu was a pioneer on the Internet, starting her own website, Marilu.com in 1999. In 2000, she began teaching online classes for her growing membership, as well as offering online counseling and support along with her twenty coaches who teach her Total Health Makeover (THM) lifestyle.

Marilu has spoken before Congress nine times on various subjects including dietary supplements, women's cardiovascular disease, The Child Nutrition Reauthorization Act of 2010, the Veggie Caucus, and deadbeat parents, and she was one of only two private citizens selected to contribute to the shaping of our government's food pyramid in 2004, and in January 2014, she again faced Congress to present healthy dietary guidelines for the 2015 Dietary Guidelines for Americans. In 2018, she spoke on behalf of Us Against Alzheimer's to ask for more money to support the research that is so badly needed to better understand Alzheimer's and dementia.

Marilu frequently lectures throughout the country as a keynote speaker and motivator for professional organizations, universities, government agencies, interest groups, and corporations on topics including memory, diet and fitness, women's health issues, cardiovascular disease, cancer survival, and child rearing, as well as lifestyle, entertainment, and business organization strategies.

She can currently be seen co-starring with Candace Cameron Bure in the Aurora Teagarden series for Hallmark and in her one woman show *Music and Memories* throughout the country.

Marilu Henner is married to Michael Brown, CEO of Browntrout Publishers, and is the proud mother of two sons, Nick and Joey. Because she practices what she preaches, Marilu has truly become the quintessential portrait of what health and fitness can do for one's life, and she loves to give back to her community in so many ways!

LYDIA BOYD COMMUNICATION AND LEADERSHIP AWARD

PRESENTED AT TODAY'S BUSINESS MEETING

In honor of Past International Director Lydia Boyd, DTM, the 2014 District 1 Council voted to establish the Lydia Boyd Communication/Leadership Award. Lydia is recognized as the first and only District Governor who led our district to number one in the world during the 1985-1986 year. By having a clear vision and empowering her team, she left a legacy of excellence in communication and leadership. Nominated members exemplify excellence on these levels: inspire others, transform norms, and strive for standards.

The Director's Advisory Board (DAB) Chair heads the award committee. All Past District 1 Governors/Directors who are Toastmasters in good standing, in a club in good standing, will be responsible for selecting the final recipient of the award. Only one recipient is selected each year and may not be self-nominated.

DISTINGUISHED TOASTMASTER AWARD

PRESENTED DURING THE HALL OF FAME

The Distinguished Toastmaster award is the highest award that Toastmasters International bestows from our education program. The DTM recognizes a superior level of achievement in both communication and leadership. To be eligible for the legacy DTM award, one must have earned an Advanced Communicator Gold and an Advanced Leader Silver award and completed a High Performance Leadership project. For a Pathways DTM award, one must 1) complete two unique learning paths, 2) serve as a club officer for 12 months, 3) serve as a club mentor or coach, 4) serve as a club sponsor or conduct a Speecraft or Youth Leadership program, 5) serve as a district officer for one year, and 6) complete a DTM project.

ROY D. GRAHAM AWARD LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

PRESENTED DURING THE HALL OF FAME

"Dean" Roy D. Graham's contributions to several districts in our region and to the entire international organization were immeasurable. He dedicated 50 years of service to Toastmasters. He served as a District Governor in 1956 and as an International Director from 1958 to 1960. The legacy of service and leadership that he left behind embodies Toastmasters International's core values: integrity, respect, service and excellence.

The 1989-90 District 1 Council approved the establishment of the award and the criteria for eligibility and selection. District 1 has been very selective as to whom is awarded this honor. Annually, a selection committee is formed including the current District Executive Committee and previous recipients of the Roy D. Graham award. District 1 is honored to present the prestigious Roy D. Graham award to this year's deserving recipients.

Qualifications for this prestigious award include:

- Attained DTM designation
- At least ten consecutive years of service in Toastmasters
- Served at least two additional years at the District level
- One additional CTM/CC or ATM/AC (10 speeches), or equal Pathway Levels, after achieving DTM
- Ten additional presentations or seminars
- Four additional outside speeches (to non-Toastmasters audiences)

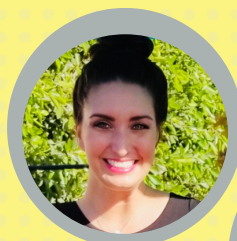
